Trees and Trails Program Report 2022

Trees – There are no major projects in regards to planting, spraying or treating trees in 2021.

Chipping – The County has released a Request for Proposal to potential bidders for the 2022 chipping program. The program will run from June 13 - August 5 and will include one pass through each neighborhood. As a reminder, your slash/chipping piles may only be placed on the street **2 weeks prior** to the week of your scheduled pick-up. Also, please refer to the Summit County website for information on the type of slash that is allowed.

Trails – We had a great turn-out for our annual work-day in 2021. Thank you to all the volunteers. We will host another work-day this year in June and will focus on the trail between the USFS “red gate” and the creek crossing below the gate. This is a volunteer activity and can be strenuous, but we will provide lunch. More information to follow in the spring. When hiking please notify us with trail concerns. Wildfire Preparedness – We continued our effort in 2021 to reduce the fuel load along our western border. Specifically, we started thinning and removing trees in 2021 above a small section of Two Cabins Drive. This work will finish early this summer. Once the snow clears, we will work with the USFS to continue these efforts along the western boundary of our neighborhood north of Two Cabins Drive. The Town of Silverthorne continues to emphasize dead tree removal, so please contact the Board if you identify any trees that are dead, whether standing or fallen.
